




# BC MUD 21 NEWS

He participated in the original Neighborhood Watch, which lasted for a few years. Unfortunately, this group fizzled out, due to lack of continued interest from new members. At that time, Director DSouza had no idea about MUD 21 and assumed it was a state government entity that just charged us annual taxes for services.

He continued to be involved in community events, more after the HOA became fully residential and members of our own community were in elected. He started attending MUD meetings soon after the 2016 elections. He learned so much and came to appreciate the amount of work and coordination it takes to keep our large



community supplied with water, sewage and relieved of our trash without interruption. Once a vacancy emerged, he expressed his interest to join the Board of Directors and was subsequently appointed by the remaining members. Director DSouza brings honesty, sincerity and a desire to help our community in any

way possible. After more than 16 years here, the whole community has become a big part of his life.

Noel can be seen almost daily walking through various parts of the community in the evenings, often 5 to 6 miles a day. He is taking note of the community's needs and getting them addressed by the appropriate entity. He also uses social media to guide fellow residents with various issues that they may not understand or have concerns with. Frequently, he is able to explain the whys and the how's. If not, he guides them to the proper party so their question can be answered. ■

**4 – Will there be any vehicles at your residence?**


**5 – Who should we call if there is an emergency? Make sure to include full name, address and phone numbers!**
